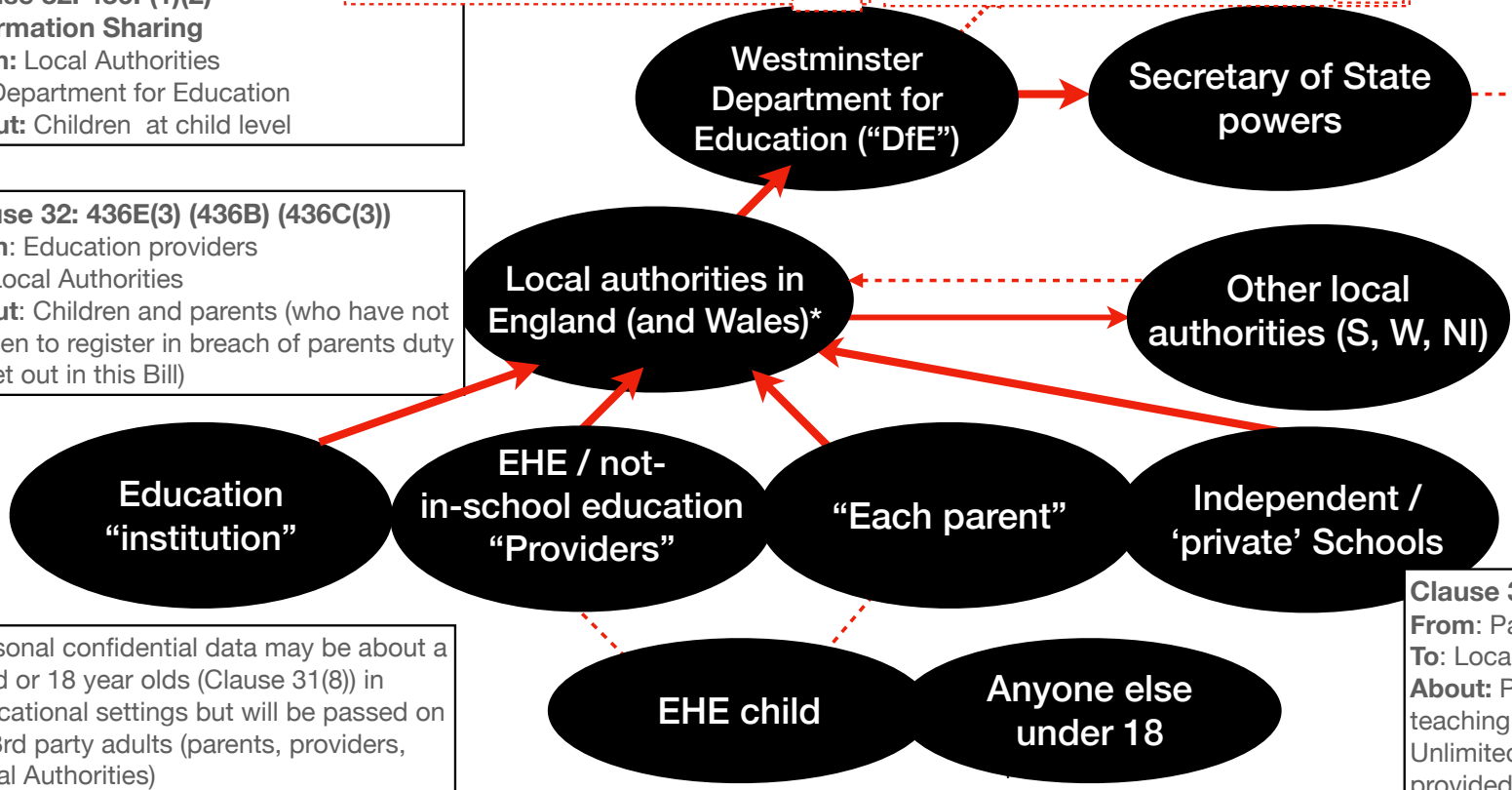

To: Local Authorities
About: Children and parents (who have not chosen to register in breach of parents duty as set out in this Bill)

Clause 4: 16LA (1-10) information sharing
From: “designated persons” (SS10 TBC)
To: “designated persons” still TBC; and others designed as a childcare or education agency for the purposes of 16E and broad definitions
About: “the information” (undefined) about children on and not on the NIS register for the purposes of for safeguarding and welfare purposes “does not breach obligation of confidence owed to the person”.

Clauses 4/32: 16LB unique ID & 436F(6-8)
From: Local Authorities in England
To: Local Authorities in Wales, Scotland, NI and “designated persons” still TBC
About: Children for the purposes of promoting or safeguarding the education or welfare, not only on the register but any other (unspecified) person under 18 (mandated) 436F(3)(b)

Clause 32: 436C/D/B
From: Parents and others
To: Local Authorities
About: Parents, children and providers giving EHE teaching without time minimum (details to be confirmed). Unlimited data (436C(3)) may not be from subjects but provided by others to create and retain in “registers”.

Personal confidential data may be about a child or 18 year olds (Clause 31(8)) in educational settings but will be passed on by 3rd party adults (parents, providers, Local Authorities)

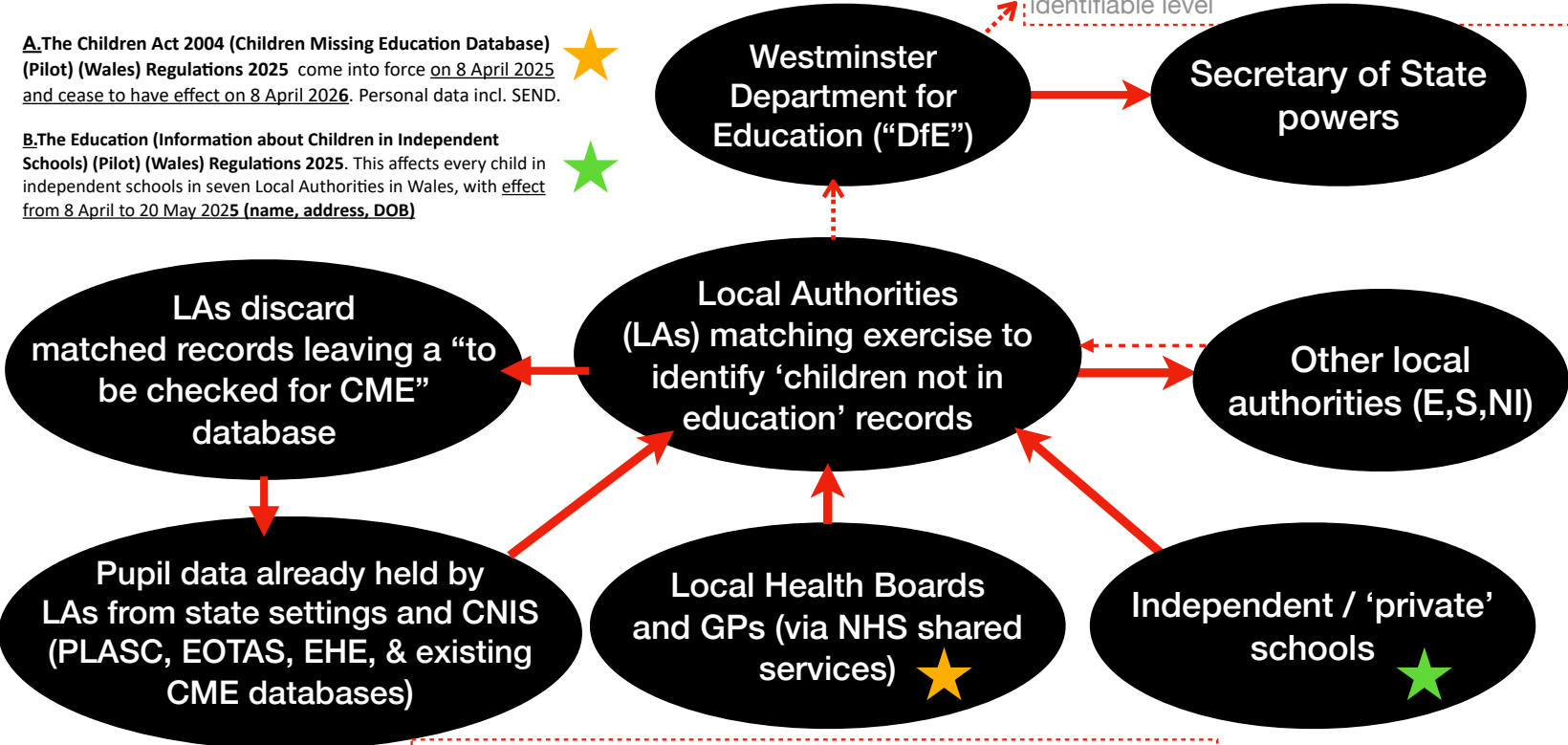

Clause 32: 436C/D/B
From: Parents and others
To: Local Authorities in Wales
About: Parents, children and providers giving EHE still (details to be confirmed). Unlimited data (436C(3)) from subjects or provided by others to create and retain in “registers”.

A. The Children Act 2004 (Children Missing Education Database) (Pilot) (Wales) Regulations 2025 come into force on 8 April 2025 and cease to have effect on 8 April 2026. Personal data incl. SEND. ★

B. The Education (Information about Children in Independent Schools) (Pilot) (Wales) Regulations 2025. This affects every child in independent schools in seven Local Authorities in Wales, with effect from 8 April to 20 May 2025 (name, address, DOB) ★
